WHEN WE SIN IT MAKES GOD SAD.

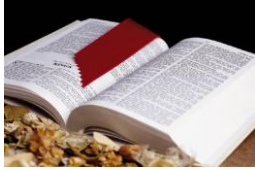


GOD LOVES US SO MUCH THAT HE SENT HIS ONLY

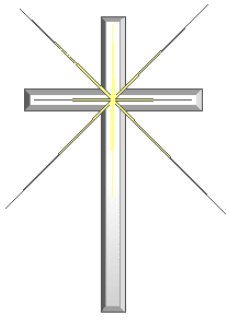
