Train Proverbs 22:6

Most states do not prohibit parents from spanking their children in all circumstances. However, all of the states have statutes that define child abuse. If a parent is accused of child abuse because he or she has struck a child then a judge or jury would need to decide whether the parent's actions constituted abuse, based on the state law as applied to the facts of the specific case.

Discipline is a form of teaching your child.

Proverbs 23:13-14 Do not hesitate to discipline a child. If you spank him, he will not die. Spank him yourself, and you will save his soul from hell.

Proverbs 22:15 A child's heart has a tendency to do wrong, but the rod of discipline removes it far away from him.

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and rebuke bestow wisdom, but an undisciplined child brings shame to his mother. Proverbs 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest: yea, he shall give delight unto your soul.

Reminders:

Colossians 3:21 Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.

We have the power of God on our side. We cannot fail. Moments matter, start now.

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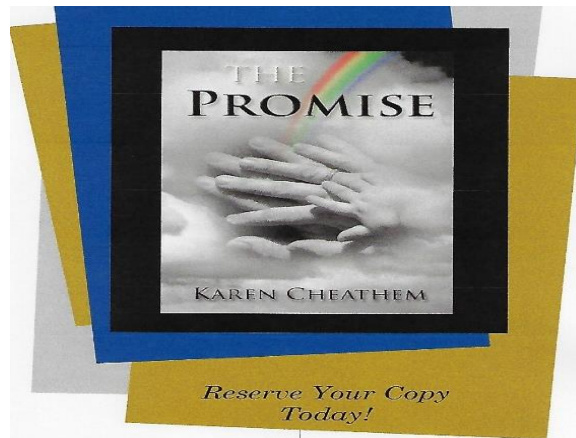
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
